## Rhode Island Unemployment Insurance Benefits Notice

Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits are available to workers who are unemployed and who meet the requirements of state UI eligibility laws.

You may file a UI claim in the first week that employment stops or work hours are reduced.

You will need to provide the Rhode Island Department of Training (DLT) with some or all of the following information in order for the state to process your claim:

- 1. Your full legal name;
- 2. Your Social Security Number; and
- 3. Your authorization to work (if you are not a US Citizen or resident).
