Unemployment Insurance Benefits Notice

Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits are available to workers who are unemployed and who meet the requirements of state UI eligibility laws.

You may file a UI claim in the first week that employment stops or work hours are reduced.

For assistance or information about filing a claim, visit dlt.ri.gov/ui/

You will need to provide the Rhode Island Department of Training (DLT) with some or all of the following information in order for the state to process your claim:

1. Your full legal name;
2. Your Social Security Number; and
3. Your authorization to work (if you are not a US Citizen or resident).
